LaBelle Fossil Camp 2017 will be run in cooperation with the LaBelle Heritage Museum

- **Where:** LaBelle Heritage Museum at 360 North Bridge Street, LaBelle, FL 33935
- **When:**
 - Camp I will be 10 through July 14th
 - Camp II will be July 17th through July 21st
 - Camp III will be July 24th through 28th
 - Camp IV will be July 31 through Aug.4th
- **Time:** The Camp day will be 8:00 am to 3:00 pm daily.
- **Tuition:** The Camp cost is \$150.00 per youth per week.

These camps are for boys and girls 8 years old through 14 years of age with an interest in fossiling. Campers will learn about the LaBelle area before the coming of humans, through fossil identification and from field fossil hunting experiences.

Curriculum overview: Each day will be broken into two parts:

- Lab experience: Campers will learn about fossil identification and care of fossils through hands-on activities. Campers will learn about the diversity of prehistoric life that lived in the LaBelle area; and,
- Field experience: Campers will learn how to find fossils and fossil sites in the LaBelle area. Field experiences is campers trying to find the fossil evidence of prehistoric life in the region. We will travel by boat and dinghy launch to known fossil sites along the Caloosahatchee River.
- Healthy snacks and drinks will be provided. Campers should bring a daily bag lunch.
- Some fossil sites will be visited via boat. If campers have a life jacket it should be brought daily. Life jackets will be provided to all campers who do not have their own. Life jackets must be worn at all times while on the boat and when hunting by the river.
- Campers will need footwear (aqua shoes or old tennis shoes for example) that can be worn in and out of the water during field experiences. Shoes must always be worn. Hats and sunscreen are also good ideas. Fossil camp will have sunscreen. Each camper will receive a fossil collecting bag and collection tools for the daily field experience. These will be needed every day.
